Item A: Question and Answers

1. Question- Can we receive a list of vendors?

Answer- Purchasing will not provide a list or recommend specific vendors. However, the Birmingham Water Works Board (BWWB) encourages collaboration between prime contractors and subcontractors. For a list of Pressure Washing vendors, registered in our system, you may contact our HUB Department. Please submit a request in writing to Dr. Thomas at felicia.irby-thomas@bwwb.org.

2. Question- What is the scope of work?

Answer: The vendor must be capable of providing pressure washing services for a total area of 5,500,000 sq. ft across 5 counties. Demand can range from one job per day to multiple jobs a day. For example, you may receive a request for Warrior at 9 am and a request for Birmingham at 11 am. The vendor is expected to be available 365 days a year, including holidays and weekends.

3. Question- What is the expectation around response time?

Answer- The vendor must arrive on-site within 1 hour of receiving a request from BWWB.

4. What happens if a vendor is unable to respond to a request?

Answer- The Board reserves the right to cancel the contract due to non-satisfactory performance or if the awarded supplier is found to violate the terms and conditions or does not correct any violations of specifications within two days after giving notice. In cases of extenuating circumstances, the Purchasing department will review the situation and determine the appropriate resolution or escalation process.

5. Question- What is the lowest temperature at which we are expected to offer pressure washing services? Answer- Vendors have successfully provided pressure washing services in temperatures as low as 19 degrees. If a vendor has concerns about potential damage to equipment due to extreme weather conditions, they are still required to report to the site. Once on-site, the Supervisor and vendor can evaluate the situation and determine the appropriate next steps on a case by case basis.

6. Question- Are there water hookups?

Answer- Where a hydrant is available and the vendor has the fire hydrant use permit, the vendor can use a meter to access the water supply. However, in some areas, water supply may be limited or not readily available. Vendors should come prepared with their own water supply or plan to access the nearest fire hydrant and return to the job site (e.g. by using a water tank).

NOTE: Please submit any necessary supporting documentation. For example, when completing the Supplier Diversity/Community Involvement Program Questionnaire, if you state that your company is a VBE or DBE, please include the valid certificate to support that statement.
